The only instances that would require us to disclose personal information (i.e. - name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, etc.) to third parties is under legal subpoena, to verify billing information with the Customer's financial institution, credit card fraud detection, or other valid law enforcement or government agency requests.

In addition, from time to time, we may market certain third party services through our site. Should you choose to accept an offer from a third party, we will pass your relevant personal information, including your name, postal address, email address and your credit/debit card number, to that third party.

You may also provide your Redress Number, if available. Security

We use Security Socket Layer 128 bit encryption on your information. This technology ensures the safety of transmitting personal information over the internet. It keeps the data that you send to Eastern Airlines private and secure.

Cookies

By using our website some information may be automatically collected by our Web servers as you browse our site. Cookies are small bits of information that are stored on your computer by your Web browser. They are used to in order to make websites work, as well as to provide business and marketing information to the owners of the site. The main way we use this information is to fulfil your traveling requirements and maintain your records.

Children

Other than information required to complete a booking, Eastern does not knowingly collect personal identifiable information from children under the age of 13.
